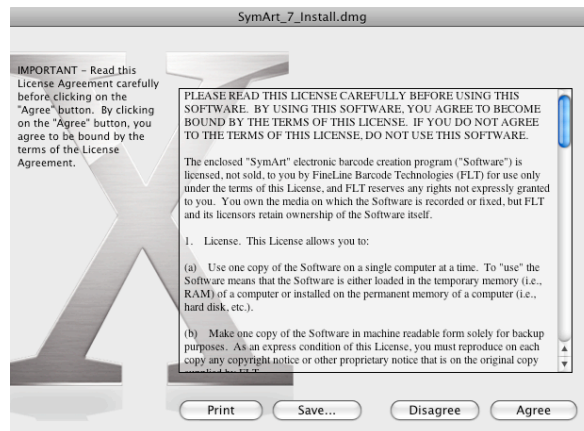

Installing SymArt on Mac OSX:

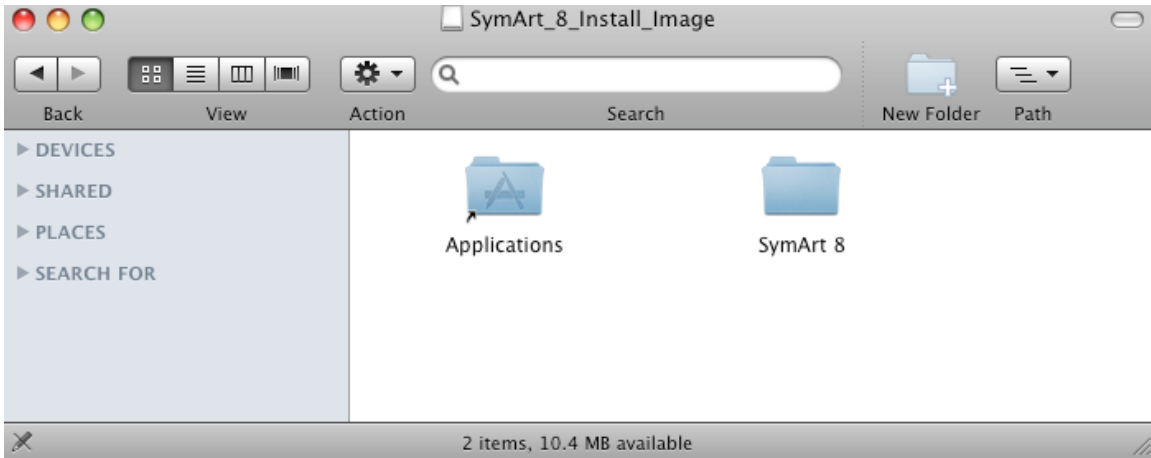
1. Insert the SymArt Installation CD into your computer and locate the SymArt_7_Install.dmg file on your CD:



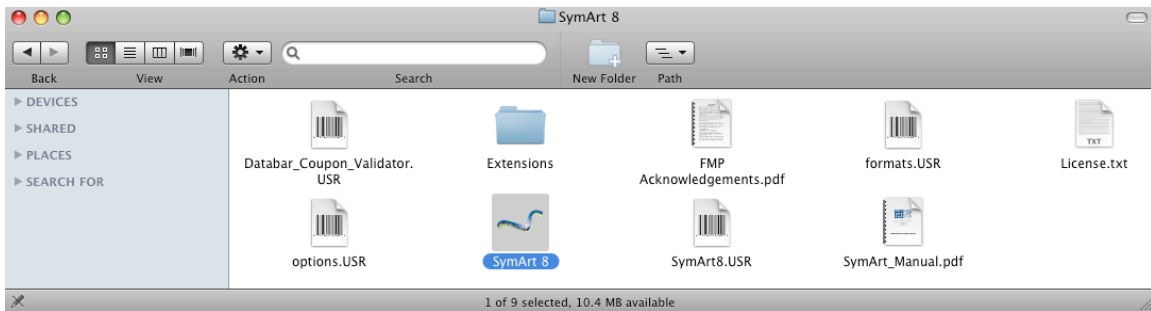
2. Double click the .dmg file and review the software license.



3. A Finder window should open with a SymArt Folder and a shortcut to your Applications folder. Simply Drag (or copy) the SymArt 8 folder into the Applications folder. You may also copy the SymArt 8 folder to any location on your hard drive if you desire.



4. Inside the SymArt 8 Folder, double click the SymArt 8 Icon to launch the application.



4. Once you've opened the software, you'll be asked to fill in your Licensing and Registration Information. You'll need to input the license number that came with your software, the company name, and user name.



5. Once you've entered this information, click "Activate" and you are ready to begin!
